

Faculty of Science and Technology Notification on Scholarships to support inbound exchange students for fiscal year 2024

In order to encourage international education and research standards according to the policy of Thammasat University, The Faculty of Science and Technology has provided a scholarship to support exchange students at the Faculty of Science and Technology. The objective is to support the expenses of accepted inbound students from other abroad institutions that have joint academic cooperation agreements with the Faculty of Science and Technology or with Thammasat University for academic activities, including conducting research within the faculty. Therefore, applications are open for selection of students who wish to study and research with financial support. The details are as follows.

- 1. Scholarship limit and requirements
- 1.1 The Faculty supports the amount of expenses according to actual expenses, not more than 35,000 (thirty five thousand) baht only per scholarship recipient.
- 1.2 The Faculty will allocate a quota for the scholarships. Departments will select scholarship candidates and submit the name of the student who meets the conditions to the faculty.
- 1.3 The recipient must do research or academic activities in the Faculty of Science and Technology.
- 1.4 The Faculty's International Affairs committee will consider candidates' applications and inform the details of the expenses that will be supported. These expenses can be disbursed according to the Royal Thai Government's disbursement regulations and will be announced on the date of the announcement of the list of scholarship recipients.
- 1.5 In the event that the required expenses exceed the amount that the faculty supports or a non-reimbursable expense with respect to the Royal Thai government's disburse regulations, the student is responsible for such expenses.
- 1.6 The student must submit acceptable evidence and complete the disbursement process of supported expenses with the administration and finance of the faculty within 15 days from the date of returning from Thailand.

- 2. Applicant conditions and qualifications
- 2.1 Be a student from a foreign institution or agency that has academic or research activities or a joint academic cooperation agreement with the Faculty of Science and Technology, or with Thammasat University.
- 2.2 An applicant of an undergraduate scholarship must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) that is not less than 2.75 on the scale of 4.0, and an applicant of a master's degree or doctoral degree must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of not less than 3.25 on the scale of 4.0.

For graduate students who do not have a grade point average (GPA) because they are in their first semester, or studying in a research-intensive course without studying courses, their academic results at the bachelor's degree level will be considered and must not be less than 2.75.

- 2.3 Each department selects candidates based on their selection conditions. Students must have proficiency in English language either with a TOEFL iBT score of not less than 64, or IELTS of not less than 5.0, or TOEIC not less than 600 and is outstanding in educational qualifications or received the selection's interview score at a very good level. If the interview committee sees that the applicant has all the qualifications, they can provide comments for the ability of the candidate to receive a scholarship as a special case. It is deemed to be in the discretion of the Board of Directors when considering granting scholarships to candidate students.
- 2.4 The recipient must do research or academic activities for a period of not less than 2 weeks.
- 2.5 In the case that the applicant is already a recipient of another scholarship with similar scholarship conditions, it is up to the discretion of the Faculty's International Relations Committee to consider the qualifications of the applicant.
- 2.6 The exchange must comply with the conditions announced by Thammasat University regarding the guidelines for implementing the student exchange program from the latest edition of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak situation.
 - 3. Application for a scholarship

Students wishing to apply for scholarships according to this announcement must prepare documents as follows.

- 3.1 An application form (as per the attachment at the end of the announcement or download it at http://iac.sci.tu.ac.th)
 - 3.2 Copy of academic transcripts

- 3.3 A copy of the English language test scores or a letter from the interview committee
 - 4. Application Schedule
- 4.1 Students must submit application documents through a faculty member in the department of their interest any time from the starting date of this announcement onwards until 10 July 2024.
- 4.2 Announcement of the list of scholarship recipients will be announced at the end of the subsequent month of the application or as appropriate.

This announcement shall be effective from 18 October 2023
